GeoVi's (pronounced gee-oh-veez) Home for New Life is named in

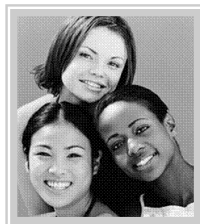

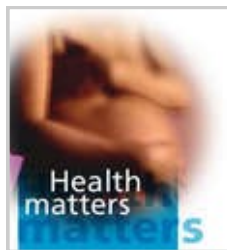
## ADMISSIONS CRITERIA
